We are very excited that your child will be a part of our Awana ministry this year! The goal for our Awana Ministry is to create an environment that helps children know Jesus, love Jesus, and serve Jesus. This goal is reached by clubbers memorizing Scripture each week under the guidance of a listening team that is ready, committed, and willing to help each child. For this to happen we need your help and support.

All Awana participants are encouraged to come ready with their Awana Wear on, Bible, and Index Card with the weeks Scripture verse in hand ready to present at check in time. Points will be awarded accordingly.

Each clubber will receive the weekly Scripture verse booklet at the beginning of the new Awana year. Each clubber is encouraged to do as much Scripture examination & memorization at home to help ready him/her for small group time.

We want Awana to be an exciting, encouraging, and educating time for all clubber's. In order to create an effective and efficient ministry environment, we expect all clubber's to know and follow our Awana Ministry expectation and guidelines.

Awana Expectation/Guidelines

NO - fighting/ inappropriate physical contact/ mean spirited verbal remarks from clubbers

NO - object of any kind for the use of harming other clubbers

NO- inappropriate toy, gadget, or printed material

An Electronic Device is welcomed as long as it contains a version of the Bible (preferably NKJV) or used as a writing table to take notes

Clubbers will be expected at all times to SHOW RESPECT to all clubbers and Adult servants

Clubbers will be expected to come with their Awana T-Shirt on or if not appropriate/modest attire

Clubbers will be expected to have close toe sneakers on for play in the Awana Games

Clubbers with SICKNESS need to stay home until Clubber is well again - fever, vomiting, diarrhea, colds, undiagnosed rashes, lice, etc.....

Gracious warnings will be given to individual clubbers who neglect to follow the Awana guidelines. Clubber's who do not comply after gracious warnings will lose privileges and prizes. Parents will also be contacted when a Clubber willfully and continually disobeys our Awana guidelines.
